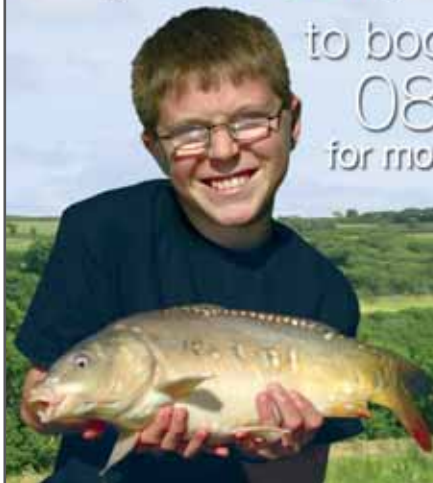

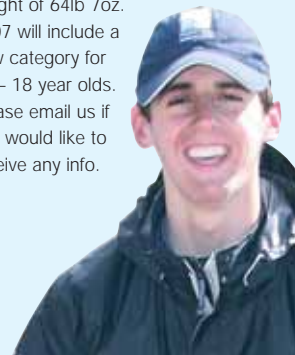
amazing prizes for junior fest

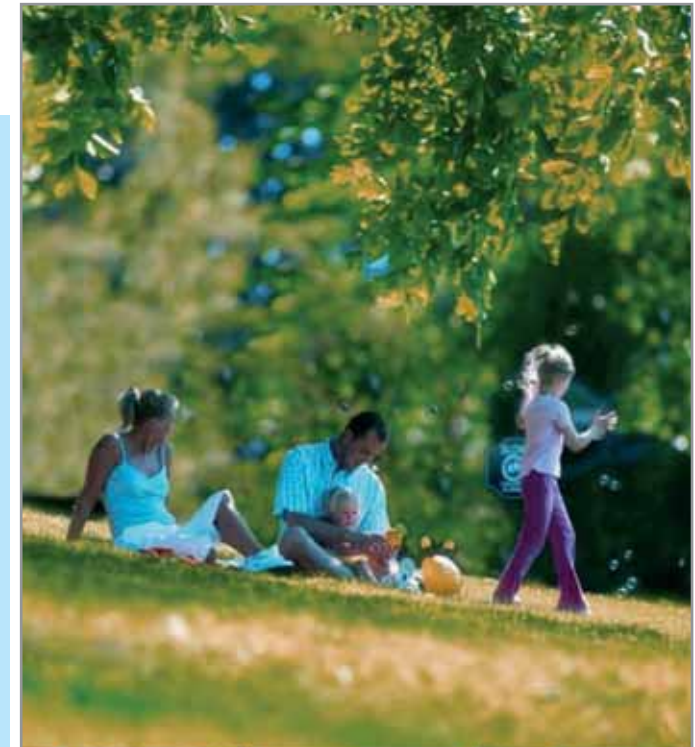

The lake fished better than ever with weights of 35lb of Roach and perch and even bigger bags of Bream. Entry was a little disappointing but the event will run again next year and we have already excited anglers eager to return to the festival and those that are waiting to fish next year.

The results were tight with the top three tied on points so it went down to weight in the end, **Simon Jones** was the winner of the first ever Porth festival with 18 points and 98lb 13oz, just missing out on the top spot was **Paul Greenwood** also with 18 points but only 96lb 5oz, our very own **Clint Elliott** was third with 18 points and 81lb 10oz.

daiwa festival winners

This year's **Daiwa** festival took place in September to avoid the spawning season thus adding to the quality of the fishing. The festival was fished over 4 days on both sides of Twin Oaks, Canal & Acorn and was won by **Danny Eason** who finished a point clear of the others after picking up two section wins and two seconds, Danny finished with a weight of 174lb 5oz. The festival was tight until the last day as **James Cooper** finished with a great weight of 183lb 5oz but was beaten into second as he picked up a section win and three seconds leaving him with 33 points. Third went to **Andy Pell** with 32 points and a weight of 164lb 8oz, it was close to the final whistle and Andy's fate was sealed when he only managed a third in section on the final day to add to his win and two seconds. The 2007 festival will be back next July.

With all the great match fishing results we have here at **White Acres** sometimes the specimen fishing gets overlooked here. We have two specimen lakes Pats and Nelsons, Nelsons is home to big carp whilst Pats is home to big carp and Catfish and boy have we had some big cat catches this year. In June we had our record broken for the first time for the year when **Mike Hermle** (pictured) caught his Catfish weighing 56lb 12oz. The year continued to get better when Anthony Simmonds landed a 58lb 12oz Catfish on the 24th September, this smashed the record and is currently our largest Catfish to date out of Pats Pool. With the fairly mild

climate in Cornwall it is no wonder the fishing is good all year round, this also now applies to the specimen fishing as the catfish are notorious in not feeding in the autumn months but this was proven wrong by **Mark Tate** who landed a 58lb 8oz at the end of October! So the current record for a catfish is now 58lb 12oz, does anyone feel up to the challenge for 2007 if not Anthony will remain our record holder.

Solero Winners!

three section wins giving her 15 points and an overall weight of 134lb 15oz, Day one saw Wendy draw on Acorn a lake she hadn't fished before but she approached it confidently fishing with punched bread on the hook to catch 21 carp plus a couple of bonus fish on hair rigged meat to win her section. Days 2 & 3 saw her stick with a method she now felt comfortable with and fished both days predominantly on bunched bread on the bomb and pellet on the waggler providing her with another 2 section wins to take the festival victory. Wendy said she thoroughly enjoyed the festival with good competitive fishing and great company, she hoped that the festival would go from strength to strength and she will definitely be back next year. **Wendy Halliday** finished second on the festival with 13 points and a weight of 109lb 13oz and **Gaynor Mills** picked up third with 12 points and 121lb 3oz.

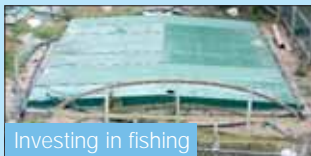
predator fencing

As **White Acres** is in the middle of the Cornish countryside, it is to be expected that we have a lot of wildlife around us, some of which is proving to be problematic with our **lakes**. You might have noticed a lot of activity going on around the perimeter of the park. We have been erecting a three-strand electric fence to secure our fish stocks against otters and mink. The fence works the same way as a cattle fence, it is low voltage and **won't harm** the animal, it runs off a sensor to come on from dusk, so will be protecting the lakes against any late night visitors but will be off during the day time in case any of our younger visitors wonder off!

healthy waters

With the recent epidemic of fish disease spreading throughout the country and the never ending battle against low oxygen **White Acres** yet again will be setting new standards in fishery management. We will be investing into the future of fishing by setting up possibly the first **bacterial water filter** to be used by a commercial fishery. The filter will work just like an over sized pond filter but will be able to filter up to 45,000 gallons of lake water per day.

Not only will the plant filter the water but it will also **re-oxygenate** as it passes through the filter media. The water will be gravity fed from Jenny's lake into the filter, then once filtered it will be pumped into Python, gravity fed into Pollawyn, from Pollawyn through a reed bed filter then into Pats Pool. At this point the water will be pumped all the way back up into Jenny's lake where the cycle will start all over again.
